



## Karin Arbach

She is an independent researcher at the National Scientific and Technical Research Council (CONICET) and a professor of Clinical Criminology at the Faculty of Psychology at the National University of Córdoba (UNC). She is an associate researcher at the Advanced Studies Group on Violence at the University of Barcelona, where she completed her doctorate and worked as a researcher between 2001 and 2012 until her repatriation to Argentina. In 2012, she completed a postdoctoral stay at the Institute of Criminology at the University of Cambridge (United Kingdom).

Within the framework of the CONICET Science and Justice Program, she provides advice and institutional training to public and private entities on issues related to the evaluation of the risk of violence based on evidence, treatment and rehabilitation models for offenders.

She teaches in postgraduate courses and master's degrees. She supervises undergraduate, graduate and doctoral theses. She is a reviewer for scientific journals, such as the Journal of the International Association of Forensic Mental Health Services, Criminal Justice and Behavior, Journal of Interpersonal Violence, Anuario de Psicología, Revista Mexicana de Psicología, Revista Argentina de Ciencias del Comportamiento and Evaluar.

She is director of projects funded by the National Agency for Scientific and Technological Promotion (PICT 2015), CONICET (PIP 2015), Ministry of Science and Technology of the Province of Córdoba (PID 2013), Secretariat of Science and Technology of the National University of Córdoba (CONSOLIDAR Project 2018, Type "A" Projects, 2014, 2016), Center for Legal Studies and Specialized Training (2006, 2008), Secretary of Youth of the Generalitat de Catalunya (2007), among others.

She is a member of the Academic Committee of the Doctorate in Psychology at the National University of Córdoba and a member of the International Association of Forensic Mental Health Services. She has been director of the Postgraduate Course in Criminal Psychology at the National University of Córdoba and has organized multiple academic professional training activities, especially at the University of Barcelona.
