He is a professor of Social Psychology at the Autonomous University of Madrid and heads the Department of Strategic and Intelligence Studies at the Institute of Forensic and Security Sciences (ICFS-UAM). He collaborates with various universities and public and private organizations as a teacher, researcher and advisor. He has carried out research stays at various Spanish and foreign universities, including the London School of Economics and Political Science and the Centre for Studies of Terrorism and Political Violence at the University of St. Andrews (United Kingdom). He is a member of the group of experts of the International Observatory of Studies on Terrorism, the Association of Spanish Graduates in Security and Defense (ADESyD), the Latin American Network of Security and Organized Crime (RELASEDOR), the Spanish Scientific Society of Social Psychology and the Institute of Ceuta Studies. In 2014 he received the Cross of the Order of Merit of the Civil Guard with white insignia.

His main lines of current research focus on issues related to Security and Defense, especially terrorism and other forms of political violence, conflict analysis, organized crime and intelligence studies.
